POST SHAVE BIOPSY CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- You have had a 'shave biopsy' performed today. There will be no sutures, but a dressing has been applied to absorb any bleeding or ooze. This dressing may be soaked off in the shower tomorrow. The wound will form a scab over the next two days. Keep the wound open and shower / shampoo normally, gently cleaning under running water on a daily basis to remove any crust. You may apply a small amount of Vaseline on the wound after drying.
- If you develop any signs of infection, bleeding or any other complications, please call Dr Jeremy Banky, and arrange a review appointment so he can assess your biopsy site.
- Your pathology result will probably be told to you via telephone. If any further treatment is required, a booking will be made for you when the result is told to you.
